In response to the recent criminal activity in the area around campus, we encourage the campus community to review the following safety tips

- Avoid areas that are dark or isolated.
- Look confident when you walk and walk in groups
- Have your keys in your hand as you approach your car
- If you sense imminent danger remove yourself from the area, trust your instincts
- Park in well-lit areas; lock all doors, roll up windows and remove all property inside the vehicle
- Check around and inside your car before getting in
- Consider the shoes you wear and your ability to escape from an assailant
- Carry and use a high-pitched sounding device like a whistle to ward off an attacker and to summon for help
- Use the Campus Safety Escort Program during hours of darkness 951-827-3772
- Use the campus shuttle and bus systems which are located throughout campus and outlying parking lots
- Keep personal belongings in view while eating, meeting, or shopping on campus
- If you must be in an isolated area, e.g., working or studying alone in labs or offices, lock the doors and tell a friend where you are and when you plan to leave
- Try not to walk or jog at night by yourself. Use the buddy system, escort service or campus shuttles
- Be aware of your surroundings (especially when using a cell phone or Ipod)
- Notify the Police Department of suspicious individuals who appear to be "hanging around"
- If you leave for an extended vacation, take high-value personal property with you
